

The Venue

Entrance

The main entrance is via a block paved, level pathway. The Venue main doors are automatic.

Reception area

There is a reception counter, with a lowered section. A portable infra-red induction hearing loop is available from Guest Services Reception. If required, this should be requested at time of booking.

Conference rooms

There are 7 meeting rooms. Two of these rooms have small ramps at the fire exit doors. These doors escape onto a small block paved area, then for a short distance onto bark-mulched ground, then onto the main pathway.

For conferences, prior arrangements can be made for parking in close proximity and for guests to be met by staff to provide assistance.

Bar area

The bar is not provided with a lowered counter area. However, staff will assist in any way necessary to provide service at the bar or waiter service if requested.

Lighting

General lighting in the Venue is normally to daylight standard, however it may be subdued for particular events, particularly discos. All the conference rooms have natural daylight and lighting in all conference rooms is adjustable.

If a stage has been requested, this is 40cm in height.

Accessible toilets

Accessible toilets are available within the Venue.

Noise

Noise levels vary with activity. Please discuss particular events with booking desk where relevant.

Organised events and activities

Carers or personal assistants are welcome to attend free of charge to assist a guest with disabilities. However, notification is required so that numbers at the venue do not exceed licence restrictions. Should the carer or personal assistant wish to eat, there will be a charge for the meal only.

Children's parties

Held at specific times of the year, (e.g. Christmas and Halloween). Music is played throughout. An entertainer entertains the children and games are played.
