Segways

The Segways Activity starts at the Outdoor Activity Centre which is sited near the perimeter of the site.

The Outdoor Activity Centre has level access through double opening doors.

The centre is fully accessible inside.

There is an accessible toilet. Lockers are also accessible within the building.

This area is at the top of the site on a hill. A Mobility vehicle is available to access this area for wheelchair users and ambulant guests who have difficulty walking substantial distances. Please note that due to space constraints, only the person who is unable to walk and a carer may be able to be carried in the vehicle. Please notify the staff at the time of booking if this service is required.

The Segway practice session takes place in the vicinity of the OAC. Following this the group will move out into the village using pathways and roads.

To take part in this activity, guests require full use of arms and legs and must be able to understand the safety briefing and activity instructions. They must be able to stand for 45 minutes and have the ability to balance. The ability to observe and anticipate hazards on pathways and roads.
